This **FREE** event provides veterans and non-veterans affected by homelessness or at-risk of homelessness with connections to services to improve their lives and aid in transitioning to community living. Doors open and on-site registration begins at 9:00 a.m.

The tentative event schedule includes a Welcome/Opening Ceremony from 9:30 to 9:45 a.m.; a Resource Fair featuring over 100 social service programs providing veteran and non-veteran specific services, from 9:45 a.m. to noon; free haircuts available through 12:15 p.m.; and lunch beginning at 12:00 p.m. This is a great opportunity for those in need to reconnect with the community.

TRANSPORTATION: Participants can ride the CR Transit System free on Stand Down day. Simply tell the driver you are attending Stand Down. Route #1 stops at Veterans Memorial Stadium, making it easy to get to the event. Please email Info@VetsStandDown.org should you require additional transportation. All transportation reservations will need to be made by August 28th.
